A short checklist to get your property ready for dirt work. Questions on any item? **Call us — that's what the walk-through is for.**

MARK WHAT'S UNDER AND OVER THE GROUND

- ☐ Call **811** at least 3 business days ahead so buried utilities get flagged — it's free.
- ☐ Mark private lines 811 won't know about: well lines, septic tanks and field lines, propane runs, buried electric to shops or gates.
- ☐ Note any low power lines or tree limbs over the access route.

WALK YOUR LAND AND TAKE NOTES

- ☐ Flag your property corners or fence lines near the work area.
- ☐ Note where water stands after a good rain — drainage drives every decision we make.
- ☐ Decide what stays: trees you love, fences, outbuildings, garden spots.

CLEAR THE WAY

- ☐ Move vehicles, trailers, and equipment out of the work and access areas.
- ☐ Plan for pets and livestock — gates will be open and machines will be moving.
- ☐ Make sure a loaded dump truck can reach the site (about 10 ft wide, firm ground).

The easiest prep of all: snap a few photos of your property and text them to us before we come out. It helps us show up with the right machine the first time.
